To register additional family members, please copy this form and **return all registration forms together with one payment**. Proof of age may be required for new players.

FORMATION OF TEAMS : LCYSA is required to declare the number of teams for each age group. After registration has closed, LCYSA board members and coaches will assign players to teams. Under BC Soccer rules, LCYSA is not permitted to play anyone below their age group (unless specific medical conditions exist). Situations may arise where players may need to play "up an age group", or teams may need to be reorganized in order to facilitate the maximum number of youths playing in LCYSA. Under BC Soccer mandate, LCYSA is not required to accommodate requests that leave players together from year to year. Grouping of players from the same school or area may be considered, but cannot be guaranteed. Any requests to re-position players will only be discussed with the respective coaching staff.

UNIFORMS AND EQUIPMENT : LCYSA requires each player to represent the Association in a proper and professional manner. Each player is to display the full uniform sanctioned by LCYSA for each and every official game. The full uniform for U7-U18 includes Jersey, Shorts, and Socks. Players are also required to wear suitable soccer footwear, and shin guards, for all games and practices. Prior to the start of the season, each team is provided a full uniform for each registered player on the team. A range of applicable sizes are provided the team for each age group, with a provision for size adjustments before the first official game. Any requests for uniform adjustments will only be discussed with the respective coaching staff.

INVOLVEMENT AND PARTICIPATION : LCYSA has approximately 500 player and volunteer participants. The volunteer program has allowed us to offer a quality soccer program in our community of Lake Country.
